Few Distant Counties Yet to Be Heard From.

102,000 VOTES IN STATE

Practically Complete Official Returns Give Chamberlain Plurality on Over Candidates.

Practically complete official returns give Governor Chamberlain, Democratic nominee for United States Senator, a plurality of 197 over H. M. Calk, the Republican nominee. In the Senatorial contest the official count in Curry and Sherman counties has not been reported, but both of these counties probably will give Calk a small plurality, estimated at 59 and 88 respectively. In the figures on Senator, those from Baker, Crook and Klamath are unofficial, while the vote for the rival candidates in Harney, Malheur and Wheeler was estimated on a basis of the incomplete returns from those counties. The figures from all other counties are official and it is reasonably certain that the completed count will not alter the totals as they have been compiled by the Oregonian, and which give Calk 48,783, Chamberlain 31,736, and Sherman 1,239. Representative Ellis has been re-elected to Congress by a plurality of 23,115, the vote being: Ellis, 24,892; Jeffrey, Democrat, 12,774.
