Dr. Riley Holding Daily and Night Services at White Temple. At the White Temple last night Dr. Riley preached on the subject, "Are There Any Sinners in Portland?" Before he finished his sermon it was very easy to believe that there are a good many. Tall, with a stately figure and dark, magnetic eyes, Dr. Riley is a most forceful speaker, and holds the close attention of his audience throughout his sermon. Great congregations are being drawn to the White Temple every night and the meetings are increasing in power and interest.

Mr. Martin and his great chorus choir form one of the attractive features of these services. Beginning with today, two services will be held at the White Temple. The following topics will be discussed each night at 7:45. Tonight, "What Are Portland's Besetting Sins?" Wednesday night, "Are Portland People Presumptuously Sinful?" Thursday night, "Are Any Committing the Unpardonable Sin?" Friday night, "What Is to Be Told at the Confessional?" The services in the daytime will be held at 8 o'clock each morning. This early hour has been chosen in order to make it convenient for business men to attend the service and go on to their business at 9 o'clock. The service will be just one hour in length. It is believed that the women will find it equally agreeable to attend this early morning service as the men. At these morning services Dr. Riley will discuss the Book of Jonah, answering the question, "Was Jonah a Myth or a Man?" The special topic for this morning will be "Jonah in the Storm." This afternoon at 2 o'clock he will speak at the University Park Baptist Church.
