Saionji Resents Criticism of Policy of Retrenchment.

WHOLE CABINET TO RESIGN

Financial Economy Will Be Pursued by Katsura, Probable Successor, Whom Saionji Will Support in Diet.

TOKYO, July 3.—The Associated Press was informed today that the Premier, Marquis Saionji, decided some days ago to tender his resignation.

The nominal reason for Marquis Saionji's resignation is ill health. The Cabinet are all strict members of the Seiyu or Constitutional party and it was, therefore, necessary that they resign with him.

There is reason to believe that Marquis Saionji will support Marquis Katsura in the Diet.

FIREWORKS CAUSE DEATH

EXPLOSION IN STORE CAUSES FIRE AND WILD PANIC. Girls Burned to Death in Trap, While Others Stampede and Leap From Windows.

CLEVELAND, Ohio, July 3.—Six persons, five women and a 5-year-old boy, are known to be dead and possibly a score of others were injured as a result of an explosion of fireworks in the F. Kresge 5 and 10-cent store on Ontario street today.

The explosion occurred just after the shift entered the store. The last 20 men were still in the cage at the bottom of the shaft, and they were drawn to the surface unharmed.

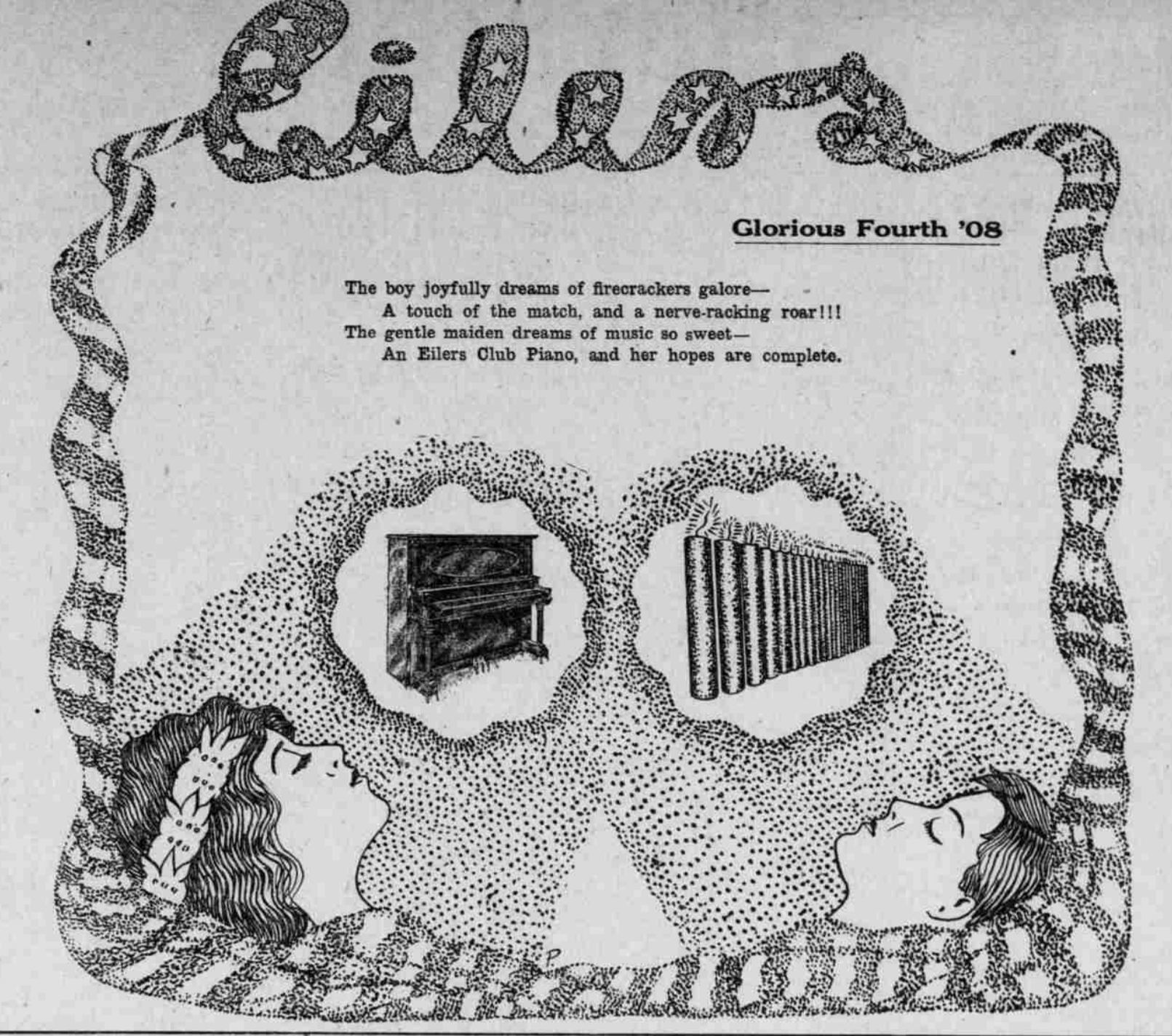
