MOUTH IS IN GOOD SHAPE

Tugboat Master Strongly Indorses Recommendations Made by Colonel Roessler—August and September Time.

"Two months' dredging at the mouth of the Columbia River, if carried on during August and September, would give 30 feet of water on the bar," said Captain Reed of the tug Wallula yesterday. "At the present time the mouth of the river is in better condition than at any time I have known in all my experience. I think that two months' work with the Chinook would be better than a year's work on the jetty. I do not find fault with the jetty but it has been of no service whatever until the rock work was raised to a point above high water."

RULES FOR LAUNCH OWNERS

Customs Inspectors Will Enforce Penalties for Violations.

Herbert Knox Smith, acting secretary of the Department of Commerce and Labor, has issued a circular letter to the Collectors of Customs of the Pacific Northwest, directing them to enforce the laws governing the operation of motor-boats. Lighted buoys are to be placed in the classes of vessels when operating after sundown, and whistles and fog bells must be carried on all craft.
