Albany Ex-Mayor Indicted. No. 2900—Indictment returned January 31, 1903, against William H. Davis, then Mayor of Albany, charging him with a violation of Section 5302, as to final proof on a homestead in Township 11.

Becker Wanted Case Dropped. This is considered confirmatory of the report that the Booth-Singleton trial began Mr. Becker's assault on the charge dismissed as against Robert A. Booth, but Francis J. Heney, who returned the indictment, refused to consent to such an arrangement and insisted that the ex-Senator should be tried jointly with the other defendants.

Case With One Conviction. No. 2912—Indictment returned February 10, 1903, against Henry Meldrum, George E. Wagoner, David W. B. Bester, Harry Winton, Gustave Klatsch, George Sorenson, L. V. Slipp and Frank H. Dugan, charging them with conspiracy in conducting a fraudulent surveying contract.
