Command of Tug Flotilla.

Captain Lamson's most distinguished services, however, were rendered during the year 1862 while he was in command of a flotilla of tugs, equipped with gunboats, on the Naumound River...

Capture of Port Walker.

It was in the capture of Port Walker, on the Naumound River, that Lieutenant Lamson achieved a notable victory over the Confederacy...

Called on General Longstreet.

Only a few years before Captain Lamson died, General Longstreet visited this city, and while here he was especially distinguished himself by his part of the war with Lieutenant W. B. Cushing...
