THE RAILROAD COMMISSION WAS CREATED for the purpose of investigating railroad service and rates and is authorized to order that reasonable services be given and a reasonable rate charged. The Commission has been busy with work of this kind ever since it was created. The state appropriates money to pay the expense of the investigations. It requires District Attorneys and the Attorney-General to aid the Commission at all times and has found all the state's attorneys ready and willing to perform their duty," declares Mr. West.

"The Commission, on its own initiative, has been working for some time on the question of grain rates in Eastern Oregon. This work we have done without aid or suggestion from Mr. Gaines. Having gathered information, he called a meeting at which a formal hearing should be had, we made an order on September 3 directing that a hearing on the reasonableness of the grain rates be held. At that time Mr. Gaines filed a complaint asking that such be had. We shall go ahead with our investigation and hearing just as though Mr. Gaines had not filed the complaint. The Commission will call witnesses and pay their mileage and per diem. The state's salaried attorneys will render all the legal aid shippers may need. I can see no reason why Eastern Oregon farmers should pay or agree to pay any man a fee in case a reduction in rates should be ordered."
