

BIG LOGGING TRADE Improvement in All Lines Since the Election.

GROCERY ORDERS GROWING Country Demand for Produce Better Than It Has Been for Many Weeks - Grain Markets Are Firmer.

In the three days since the election there has been a good gain in the volume of wholesale business. The improvement is particularly marked in the grocery line. The grocery jobbers have not had the depression secondly at any time, and in the month before the election were kept busy filling orders for canned goods and other fall commodities. Some business, however, was shown by buyers and purchases of staples were generally limited to actual requirements. Since the election the market has worn an entirely different aspect. Orders from both the city and country have been both larger in size and purchases of staples than at any time since last year. The orders are coming in from every part of the territory tributary to Portland and such confidence has been restored everywhere. There is the same improvement in the feeling shown in the produce trade, where shipping orders in the last three days have been larger than for many weeks.

Heavy Dealings in Stocks at Rising Prices.

WIDE GAINS ARE SHOWN Investment Orders Come From All Parts of the Country - Effect of Taft's Speech at Cincinnati.

NEW YORK, Nov. 6 - The speculative movement in stocks entered on a new and broader phase today with the entry into the buying movement of additional forces from widely scattered sources. The alert leaders of the speculation were prompt to perceive this development and to take advantage of it by attractive devices to help on the advance in prices. The advance was in itself a manifestation of the somewhat excited operations of the new participants, who were apparently of the class that would have withdrawn or waited if prices had moved downward instead of upward. The prospect of danger contained in this kind of movement is perfectly well recognized by the practical professional operators in stocks and this class today was attentive for signs of reaction in the market and sought to elicit profits frequently in the course of the rise. It was impressive of the extent and the force of the new buying movement that these sales were absorbed and without great impression on prices. Operations of this character, however, represent a pausing of stock holdings from stronger to weaker hands, which always results in growing vulnerability of the market to attack, and to the attraction of such an attack for the stronger speculative element, after it has disposed of its holdings. The buying orders which are being received from these sources are much larger and they are expected to come from widely separated sources, although for the most part from speculators. Speculation was much improved by the promise of the copper industry and, together with purchases of large blocks of stocks in that group, sent excited reports of the volume of the new buying movement. The advance in the price of that metal, which was in sympathy with Philadelphia and Pittsburgh, as usual, paid attention to developments in the iron and steel trade and the heavy orders for United States Steel, for the shares of the minor steel stocks and for the equipment companies and electrical equipment companies, which are correspondingly interested, were attributed to these sources to an important extent. What are called "Western wire houses" represented a clientele even more or less scattered throughout the West and South. The largest of these wire houses, however, buyers were in the industrial area, although demand for stocks of railroads with whose conditions they are familiar made itself felt. Operations for the week ending Nov. 6, 1908, were characterized by a more hopeful feeling regarding the commercial futures, orders being placed for remote delivery.
