### LORIMER TAKEN ILL

Attacked by Blood-Poisoning in Arm.

### HOPE FOR QUICK RECOVERY

Malady Starts From Abrasion Caused by Fall, and Congressman Is Confined to Bed—Serious Results Not Expected.

Congressman William Lorimer, of Chicago, is at the Portland Hotel, suffering from an attack of blood-poisoning, which developed at an early hour yesterday morning. Serious results are not expected, according to Dr. J. Kitzelson, who is attending him, though he will be confined to his bed for several days.  
The blood-poisoning resulted from a wound sustained in a tunnel on the St. Paul Railroad near Ellensburg, Wash., three weeks ago. With his son, William Lorimer, Jr., who is now with him, he was walking through the tunnel, when he slipped and fell. He suffered an abrasion on the arm, to which he paid no particular attention at the time. Last Wednesday, however, the wound began to increase in pain.  
Congressman Lorimer and son came to Portland several days ago and are at the Portland Hotel. At 2 o'clock yesterday morning the pain became so intense that it was decided to send for a physician, and Dr. J. Kitzelson was summoned. He treated the wound, and announced last night that unless unexpected complications arose, the distinguished patient would resume his trip in a few days.  
Congressman Lorimer had planned to go to Astoria yesterday morning, where he intended to inspect the work that is being done by the Government on the Columbia River Jetty. After that trip he intended to visit Ocella Falls, and then proceed to California, where he had planned to inspect the harbors and
