RECEIPTS BREAK RECORDS

Gate Money Amounts to \$8105. College Teams Leave City to Train for Thanksgiving Games at Portland and Seattle.

RECEIPTS OF GAME \$1005. The following statement of receipts and disbursements at Saturday's football game has been made by the management of the two teams:

Total receipts \$8105.00. Expenses \$1376.70. Net receipts \$6728.30.

The total receipts of Saturday's football game between U. of O. and Oregon were officially announced yesterday as \$8105, which is the largest amount of money ever paid in at a football game in the Pacific Northwest.

Each team receives \$3964.15, out of which they will be required to pay hotel bills in Portland. At that school institution has cleared at least \$2000, which means that they will be all the more favorable to playing the game in Portland each year.

The University of Oregon team went to Seattle, where they will enjoy the salt air and practice on the beach until Wednesday, when they will return to Portland for the Thanksgiving day game.

WHERE IS MIDDLE CHANNEL. Supreme Court All Wrong, Says This Correspondent.

MCGOWAN, Wash., Nov. 21.—(To the Editor.)—The Oregonian of November 17 contains a new dispatch from Washington, D. C., to the effect that the United States Supreme Court has decided the Columbia River boundary between Oregon and Washington, and which article quotes Justice Brewer as saying:

The same description of the boundary is found in the act admitting Oregon and in the Constitution of Washington, and since that time it has been the rule that the description of the middle of the north channel was named. There were at that time two channels and the northern one was the north channel and the southern one was the south channel.

and are not gifted with omniscience if they are foolishly asked by what course of reasoning the learned court construed "the middle channel of said river" into "the center of the north channel."

From this it is plain that the real boundary line does not touch the north channel at any point, but that it was specifically projected from "a point in the Pacific Ocean" to and up the middle channel of said river.

Correctly speaking, "Sand Island" was not an island, but a moving sand bar that became detached from the middle channel through a shifting of the south channel, and was situated between the south channel and the middle channel, encountered the south channel, and passed through that, bringing up upon the sands of Hobart Bay, and there it was again attached to the south side of Sand Island and the Washington shore.

There were practically no fish traps in Baker Bay prior to 1880 and but few prior to 1884, but the north channel had already been closed by the shifting of the south side of Sand Island and had shifted to its south side.

Had no jetty been built you would now have a regular channel through what is at present called the "Jetty Sands," and which would be situated between the south channel and the north channel, and would be a regular channel across the river, to impinge upon the present so-called "Sand Island" on the north side.

There was a "middle channel" at the time the boundary was declared, and in the present so-called Sand Island north or south of that "middle channel."
