COURTSHIP TOWNSHIP LOSES

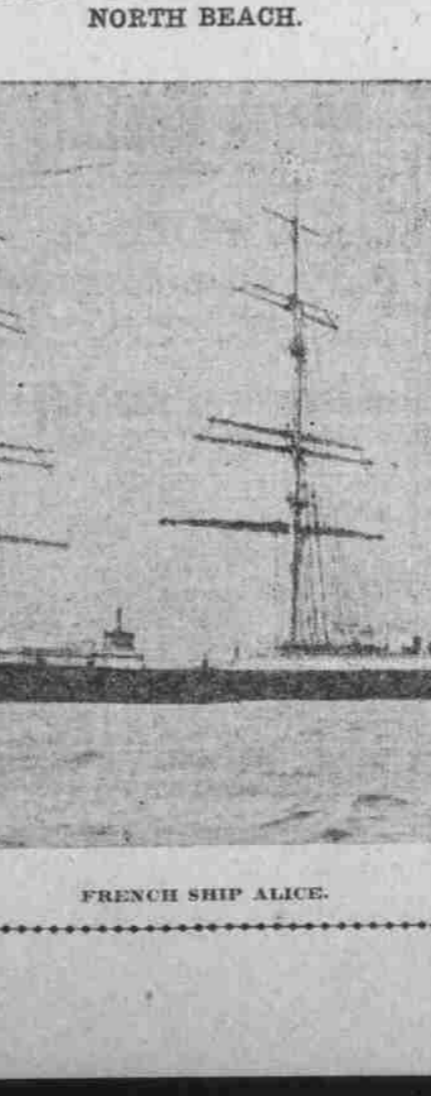
