

PEARL MILLION GIVE COLUMBIA

Appropriations Amounting to
\$950,000 Made in Two Bills
Reported in House.

WEST IS WELL CARED FOR

Beside Columbia River Work, Bills
Provide for Federal Buildings,
and Surveys of Yakima and
Willamette Rivers.

OREGONIAN NEWS BUREAU, Wash-
ington, Feb. 19.—Two bills reported to the
House of Representatives today carry an
aggregated appropriation of \$950,000 for the
month of the Columbia River. The sundry
civil bill contains \$250,000 to complete
outstanding contracts, and the river and
harbor bill carries \$700,000 for new con-
struction, and \$200,000 for repairing and
operating the docks. The sundry civil bill
also carries \$100,000 for completing the
existing contract on the Columbia River.
The sundry civil bill also carries appropria-
tions of \$114,400 for two double bar-
racks and \$20,000 for a field artillery bar-
racks at Vancouver, and \$25,000 for new
barracks at Fort Stevens, and also items
to complete public buildings at Eugene,
\$30,000; La Grande, \$40,000; Spokane, \$15-
000; and Walla Walla, \$40,000. Crater Lake
Park gets but \$2000.
In the river and harbor bill no single
channel or improvement is to be allotted
more than \$50,000 out of the appropriation
for emergency.
The Secretary of War is directed to take
proceedings immediately for the reclamation
of the property and lands of the
various water power companies along the
channel of the St. Mary's River by con-
demnation or otherwise, payment to be
made out of any money authorized or
appropriated for the improvement of the
St. Mary's River at the falls.
Cancel Power Permits.
All permits granted to the Chandler-
Dunbar Waterpower Company, the Ed-
ison Light Power Company, the Ed-
ison Light Power Company or the St.
Mary's Power Company by the United
States will be cancelled January 1, 1911.
The President is requested to open
negotiations with Great Britain for a
treaty for securing the maintenance of
ample water levels for the uses of navigation
in the great lakes by the con-
struction of controlling works in the
connecting rivers and channels of the
lakes.
Six hundred thousand dollars is ap-
propriated for investigations, surveys,
contingencies and incidental repairs for
rivers and harbors for which there is
no special appropriation. The most
important waterways for which pre-
liminary surveys and examinations are
provided aside from the Intracoastal Wa-
terway, along the Atlantic and Gulf
Coasts are:
Many Harbors Favored.
Oakland Harbor, Monterey Bay, Wil-
mington Harbor, Humboldt Bay and the
Sacramento and Feather rivers, Califor-
nia; Kahului Harbor, on the island of
Maui, and Kaneohe Bay, on Kauai Island,
Hawaii; the Chicago and Rock rivers,
Illinois; the harbors and rivers at or
near Chicago, including Chicago Harbor.
Preliminary surveys of the Columbia,
Yakima and Lower Willamette rivers,
in Oregon and Washington; Arroyo
Harbor, Porto Rico; Aransas Pass Har-
bor and Sabine Pass and the Port Ar-
thur ship canal are also provided for.
Others are the Grand River, Utah; Ta-
coma Harbor and the Columbia River,
Washington.

FORTIFICATION BILL PASSED

House Votes to Defend San Pedro,
Not Reduce Powder Price.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 19.—General
debate on the fortifications appropria-
tion bill having been concluded, the

NATION SECURES BIG TREES

Exchanges Other Forest Land for
Famous Calaveras Grove.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 19.—President
Roosevelt, by signing the bill for the
creation of the Calaveras National forest,
California, has completed legislation
which saves for all time the most famous
grove of trees in the world. This act is
the culmination of efforts extending
over the past nine years.
No Treasury appropriation is needed
to carry out the provisions of the act.
Robert B. Whitledge, of Duluth, Minn.,
owner of the big tree groves, receiving
in exchange therefrom stumps of equal
value on other forest land owned by the
Government.
The bill has the support of the entire
California delegation in Congress.

DEBATE BLOCKS STATEHOOD

But Little Chance for Arizona and
New Mexico This Session.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 19.—The re-
quirement that Congress instead of the
President shall approve the constitution
adopted by a new state was urged
by Senator Nelson today, when the
New Mexico and Arizona statehood bill
was taken up by the Senate committee
on territories. A basis for this sugges-
tion. Senator Nelson criticized the
Oklahoma constitution, which resulted
in a general discussion of that sub-
ject. Another meeting of the commit-
tee will be held on Tuesday next. All
members of the committee declared
that the bill should have thorough con-
sideration, which makes it certain that
no action can be had at the present
session.

VOTES HUNDREDS OF MILLIONS

Senate Passes Army and Pension
Bills—Restores Agencies.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 19.—Not during
the session of Congress has such a
large amount of business by the Senate
been done as was done today. The Army
bill, carrying appropriations amounting
to \$102,000,000, and the pension bill, with
appropriations aggregating \$160,869,000
were passed. Forty-five other bills, 40 of
which had previously been favorably
acted upon by the House, were passed.
Thirty-five minutes was all the time
required for the passing of the pension bill.
An amendment was introduced
striking out the House provision for one
instead of 18 pension agents and leaving
13 agents as now fixed by law.

Pearl Harbor Dock Smaller.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 19.—Congress
having failed to increase the limit of
cost for the proposed new drydock at
Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, to \$3,000,000, as re-
commended by Secretary Newberry, new
bills will be asked for, which will con-
template the construction of a dock con-
siderably smaller than the 119 feet long
originally proposed. The Secretary re-
jected all bids under the recent advertise-
ment, the lowest being much higher than
the limit authorized.

Naval Commission Meets.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 19.—President
Roosevelt's naval reorganization com-
mission which has under consideration
