

HERSELF
WROTE LETTER
Mystery Cleared Up, but Culbertson
Says Mrs. Langwell Should
Clear Her Name by Pro-
ving Alibi, if She Can.

VINCENNES, Ind., March 26.—Mrs. Jessie Langwell, the woman of mystery, sad-hearted, though a bride of three months, was not murdered by a woman. She was self-slain. Of this there is no doubt, and her husband's relatives acknowledged today that their suspicions that she was killed at the instigation of another woman for jealous revenge were unfounded.

The trunk of a miniature skeleton, which had been attached to the skull found by the side of Mrs. Culbertson when she was discovered Wednesday in the shed near her home last Wednesday after swallowing carbolic acid, was picked up today near the scene of the tragedy. It lay concealed beneath a pile of debris where the disheartened girl had placed it after she had removed the head and attached it to the skeleton.
