SALE OPENS THURSDAY

BIG RUSH EXPECTED FOR SEATS FOR KIRKNESS.

Season Tickets Go First Two Days and on April 10 Individual Admissions Will Be Sold.

On Thursday morning at 10 o'clock the sale of season tickets for the society's Kirkness will be given April 13, 14, 16 and 17, at the Army, for the benefit of the Portland Open Air Sanatorium for Consumptives and the local Woman's Exchange, will begin at the Hellig theater box-office. William Fangle and Thomas Scott Brooke, who have the box and seat sale in charge for the big society undertaking, are looking for a box-office rush, and expect to be kept busy taking in money all day Thursday and Friday, the two days set for season ticket sales. AGRETTE NOW DOOMED

DEALERS WILL SELL NO MORE WHITE HERON FEATHERS.

Audubon Society's Crusade Bears Fruit When Fight by Milliners Is Not Made.

The egret is doomed. Women who desire to adorn their headgear with white heron feathers after this will have to use an imitation of the real article or else find some dealer who as yet remains undiscovered by the authorities. Eight leading millinery dealers and department store managers will not deal in heron feathers any more. They will not even sell such stock as they have on hand.

This was the attitude in which the dealers appeared before Justice of the Peace Olson yesterday afternoon, to answer to charges of violating the state game law by selling heron feathers.

The officers of the Oregon Audubon Society, who brought about the arrests, were agreeably surprised to learn that no fight would be made in the courts on the law. Lawyers representing the various dealers signified an intention of pleading guilty when trial comes. A continuance was granted until April 13, when it is understood, formal pleas of guilty will be entered and nominal fines levied. If any one of the dealers expects to fight the law, that intention was not made known yesterday, when it was unanimously agreed to sell no more feathers.
