Fireman Ring was notified and Small gave him back \$20, the money he had left from the purchase and he had tied himself up with a new suit of clothes and other articles of personal comfort. The police took charge of the stolen motorcycle and the unfortunate fireman had to pocket the loss of \$40. The machine was stolen from a man named Chapman in Tacoma.
