TEXANS LIKE PORTLAND

BANKERS FROM THE LONE STAR STATE COMPLIMENTARY.

Visitors Who Were Here in 1905
Astonished at City's Growth.

Portland and its future called forth gratifying comments from many members of the party of Texas bankers who arrived yesterday from California. A number of the excursionists had visited Portland at the time of the Lewis and Clark Exposition and were astonished at the progress the city has made since that time. One man remarked that Portland's increase in population since 1905 exceeded the population of the largest city in Texas.

No party of tourists that has visited this city has paid the community more compliments than those received from the latest aggregation. They seemed to take pleasure in seeing that Portland was the most beautiful city they had visited on their trip. Many even announced their intention of returning here for a longer stay after visiting the Seattle Fair. Others declared they intended arranging their affairs so they could take their summer vacation here instead of going to the northern lakes and to Europe.

The visitors were taken for a trolley ride in the forenoon to various points of interest. The view of the Tualatin Valley from Council Crest was one that deeply impressed the Texans with the scenic wonders of the surrounding country. The Forestry building at the Lewis and Clark Fairgrounds excited their wonder and admiration, as did also the roses. The entertainment of the visitors was in charge of a committee of former Texans, a committee of bankers, and the entertainment committee of the Portland Commercial Club.
