

WRIGHT EXCELLS ALL PAST FEATS

Orville Flies 80 Minutes and Travels 70 Miles, Making Circles and Eights.

COULD FLY TO BALTIMORE

Fulfills All Government Requirements Except Carrying Passenger and Says It Would Be Easy to Cross Channel.

WASHINGTON, July 20.—Establishing a new record for aviation in America, Orville Wright made a flight late today at Fort Meyer made a spectacular flight of 1 hour 20 minutes and 45 seconds' duration.

Several thousand persons saw the most daring feat of aviation yet accomplished. The machine traveled about 70 miles, as estimated by Wilbur Wright, and at one time during the flight the height attained was between 240 and 270 feet, exceeding the highest point ever reached by a heavier-than-air machine on this continent.

Circles and Makes Eights.

The machine started at 4:20 o'clock. After traveling several hundred feet only about five feet from the ground, the aeroplane rose gradually to 15 feet before making the first turn.

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TAFT GETS MONEY

Urgent Deficiency Bill as Passed Carries His Sum.

DEMOCRATS SEEK DEFEAT

President's Traveling Expenses Proposed by Bowers, but His Adherents Are Voted Down at Final Count.

WASHINGTON, July 20.—The urgent deficiency bill was passed today by the House. The sum carried by it is \$454,800, or \$20,408 more than the original sum, and includes the \$25,000 traveling expenses for the President.
