EUGENE Or., Aug. 19.-(Special.)-Freight train No. 25, consisting of 23 gars, in charge of Conductor Willet and Engineer Clark, was partially wrecked near the university grounds east of Eu-gene, at \$:30 this afternoon.

The nocident was caused by the middle arch bar breaking and throwing the car off the rails. The car continued to run on the fies for a length of 36 rails, when it left the track altogether, the car and rear trucks going to one alde of the track and the front trucks to the other.
