CLATSKANIE, Or., Aug. 23.—(Special.)—R. Kennedy, aged 35, and unmarried, committed suicide by shooting himself through the temple, at the room at the Grand Central Hotel here, about 4 o'clock this morning and was found with a revolver in his hand, lying across the bed, by the hotel proprietors when they broke the door in at 8 o'clock.

WIND WRECKS DIRIGIBLE

PARIS, Aug. 23.—The Bayard-Clement dirigible balloon, built recently by the Bayard-Clement Company for the Russian government, was wrecked today near Malson-Laitte during its preliminary trial. The dirigible was not injured. The airship made an ascent successfully, remained in the air and then came down without damage but while on the ground a violent gust of wind tore the balloon from the grasp of 40 men who were holding it.
