greater than former years.

The total rainfall for the first eight months of this year has been \$2.15 inches, while the average for the last 13 years was 40:90 inches, leaving a deficiency of 8.75 inches, which makes this year really dryer than former years. The average tamperature for July and August this year has been 63 degrees above zero.
