

WOODS ARE TOO LOW

Oregon Market Should Be Nearer 30 Cents.

BASED ON EASTERN PRICES

Sales Made in New York at 35 Cents. Several New Transactions in This State at a Quarter.

There is no mistaking the fact that a 25-cent bid market has been reached. The only point that is not clear is why the market is not higher. Based on Eastern prices, value here should be 27 or 25 cents. They will probably reach that figure in a few days and everyone looks for a 20-cent market before the month is half gone.

Several deals at 25 cents were reported yesterday. While three bought two lots at Middleton, 140 bales from A. Stein and 50 bales from C. Krueger, at that price. Julius West paid 25 cents for Oswald West's crop of 180 bales at Corvallis, and Hines & Daniels bought three lots, aggregating 125 bales, at McMinnville and North Yamhill at 25 cents, the lots being William Odell's 28 bales, J. Nichols' 27 bales and Justin Moore's 72 bales.

George Bird's representatives are reported to have taken options on two crops in the valley at 25 cents.

Three hundred bales were sold in Yakima Saturday at 25 to 26 cents and 24 cents was offered freely in Western Washington yesterday. The California market has become completely blocked since the advance to a quarter in Oregon.

The most important news from the outside during the day came in a wire from New York, which announced that 35 cents had been bid for this state and 34 cents was being freely offered, nearly all the big exporters and dealers operating. From a half to three-quarters of the New York crop has been sold.

A cable from London, of London, to Isaac Finck & Sons, was as follows: "Market firm and 3 to 10 shillings higher. German exporters in market and still buying. English buyers buying only a few lots. Home demand so far purely speculative."

Cables have been received from German and Belgian dealers asking for samples of Oregon hops, which are being sent them. Oregon hops have never before been sold in those countries, but a market may be opened up this year, as neither Belgium nor Germany have enough hops for their own consumption.

Hops sold at 25 cents.—Julius West today bought the Oswald West lot of hops, 121 bales, at 25 cents, a sale is reported from Silverton of 120 bales, medium, at 22 cents.

NO CHANGE IN LOCAL GRAIN MARKET. Wheat receipts are the heaviest of the season. A fair amount of activity was reported in the local grain market yesterday and the prices quoted showed but little change from last week.

ONION CROP OF THE UNITED STATES. Less Than That of Last Year—Total Yield of Cranberries.

The commercial onion crop of 1909 is now practically all harvested and according to the October 2 report of the American Agriculturist is placed at 4,178,000 bushels. The figures showing acreage by States placed New York in the forefront, with 1,245,000 bushels, followed by California, 1,010,000 bushels, and Wisconsin, 800,000 bushels.

CONDITION OF THE COTTON CROP. Bullish Report Is Issued by the Census.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 4.—Condition of cotton on September 25 was 58.5. The report of the Census Bureau today showed that to September 25 there had been gained from a cotton growth of 1909, 2,522,885 bales, netting round or half bales, compared with 2,643,835 in 1908.

The round bales included this year were 174, compared with 17,187 for 1908. The island cotton report for 1909 was 1,324, compared with 1,245 for 1908. The cotton statistics of the quantity of cotton netted to September 1 was announced as 1,842 bales. The report today will be netted and shipped reports transmitted by it by individual ginners.

WHEAT WEAK MOST OF THE DAY AT CHICAGO.

Wheat Weak Most of the Day at Chicago.

BUT DECLINE IS SLIGHT

Selling of May and Buying of December the Feature of Trading. Cash Wheat Is Firm. Coarse Grain Weak.

CHICAGO, Oct. 4.—A heavy trade, caused by large offerings from the Northwest, characterized the wheat market all day, with the exception of a few minutes at the opening, but losses were not material. The selling of December and buying of May by certain elevator interests furnished the only feature of the day. Cash wheat was firm.

The trend of corn was still downward. Oats developed an unattractively weak tone. In the provision market October lead was the only product to advance, closing 100 higher.
