The First United Presbyterian Church at Sixth and Montgomery streets will be dedicated tomorrow. The pastor is Rev. Frank De Witt Findley, who was called to the pastorate on the first of last June. The building was planned about a year ago and cost \$1,300, the old building being retained and used now as the assembly room for the Sunday school and meetings. After this society, the members of the different societies of the parish and finally all the children attending St. Francis Academy will receive communion. At 10:30 A. M. the solemn high mass will be celebrated. Rev. Father J. H. Black will be the celebrant, and Rev. Father Kelly, of Mount Angel, will deliver the panegyric on the saint.
