

PYTHIANS TO MEET

Conventions to Be Held in All Oregon Districts.

FIRST AT SALEM TUESDAY

Prominent Pythians From All Over Oregon to Attend—Grand Chancellor to Visit All Lodges of State.

A series of district conventions to be held during the coming four months by the different districts of the Knights of Pythias of Oregon will be inaugurated at Salem next Tuesday evening, November 3.

This first district convention, which will be held at Salem Tuesday, will be a big one. Central Lodge, of the Capital City, has invited the grand chancellor, E. H. Pythian, to meet there and all will send big delegations. This district includes Marion and Polk counties, in which are several lodges situated at Salem, Silverton, Hubbard, Aurora, Dallas, Independence and Falls City.

Prominent Pythians to Attend.

Among the prominent men of the order who will attend this convention and help celebrate the first big Pythian gathering of the Winter season are: Grand Chancellor, Judge W. L. Bradshaw, of the Dallas, supreme representative; L. M. Curt, of Albany, past grand chancellor; Gus C. Moser, of Portland, past grand chancellor; Frank Menefee, of The Dalles, grand chancellor; D. E. Moran, of Eugene, grand chancellor; W. H. Stinson, of Salem, grand keeper of records and seal; George Schumacher, of Hillsboro, grand prelate; Judge Robert C. Morrow, of Portland, chairman of the judicial committee of the Grand Lodge; Frank S. Grant, of Portland, chairman of the finance committee of the Grand Lodge; and George W. Knight, of Hubbard, grand lecturer.

All Districts to Have Conventions.

District conventions will be held during the Winter in all of the districts in the state. The Pythian lodge session at Pendleton last June, are now as follows: No. 1, Multnomah and Clackamas Counties; No. 2, Columbia and Clatsop Counties; No. 3, Washington and Yamhill Counties; No. 4, Linn and Benton Counties; No. 5, Lane and Douglas Counties; No. 6, Josephine and Clatsop Counties; No. 7, Coos County; No. 8, Wasco, Sherman and Crook Counties; No. 9, Gilliam, Wheeler and Morrow Counties; No. 10, Ematilla County; No. 11, Wallowa County; No. 12, Baker and Malheur Counties; No. 14, Union County; No. 15, Grant County; No. 16, Marion and Polk Counties; No. 17, Tillamook County. Every Pythian Lodge in the state will be visited during the coming fiscal year either by Grand Chancellor Menefee or Grand Vice-Chancellor Moran, according to definite plans which have been worked out in accordance with a system adopted at the last Grand Lodge session. Each of these officers has already begun the tour of official visits.

Grand Chancellor Completes Tour.

Grand Chancellor Menefee has just returned to his home in The Dalles from a visit to the lodges of Central Oregon, having made official visits to the lodges at Canyon City, Long Creek, Condon, Lone Rock, Mitchell, Prineville and Bend. He was accompanied on this trip by Circuit Judge R. B. Butler, of Condon, an enthusiastic Pythian Knight and one of the best orators in the order.

Grand Chancellor Menefee will make his next visit to the lodges at Roseburg and will then come northward, visiting all of the lodges in the Willamette Valley, which will take him to practically every town in the Valley.

Abd-uhl-Ataf Temer, No. 11, Dramatic Order of the Knights of Khramas, which is the fun-making branch of Pythianism, will not be idle this Winter. This temple is located in Portland, but it includes in its membership men from all parts of the state. Besides one or two big sessions will hold in its home temple, the members of this order plan to make a few pilgrimages to leading Oregon cities and initiate workers of the mythic travels into the mysteries of the desert.
