

GERMAN HOPS HIGH

Market Shows a Sudden Advance of 2 Cents.

ALL GRADES ARE STRONG

Conditions in Europe and in the East—Wheat Firm in the North—Christmas Turkey Market Will Open Today.

The German hop market has taken on a sudden advance, coming at a time when the English trade is interrupted by the budget dispute, and business in America is checked by the holiday period.

A letter just received by a local dealer from a leading London firm says in part: "The coming general elections are a somewhat disturbing factor in the market, and because the brewers naturally do not become interested in Pacific Coast hops."

Conditions in Bohemia are thus reported: "The market is quiet, but firm, and prices are well maintained. The general tendency seems to be in favor of owners, as stocks are getting small, and if Pacific Coast growers will become firm, higher prices must obtain."

The Eastern market is reported as being turned their attention largely to buying states on account of their fine quality and the short supply of the Germans.
