

TRACKS TO BE WIDER

Carlines to Southeastern Suburbs to Be Standard.

TO USE MADISON BRIDGE

Railway Company Intends to Relieve Madison Bridge by Diverting Traffic of Waverly-Woodstock and Richmond Lines.

Standard gauging of two miles of street railway in East Portland is under consideration by the Portland Railway, Light & Power Company and will probably be ordered in the near future.

The lines to be widened are the Waverly-Woodstock and Waverly-Richmond, embracing about 40 blocks of double track, the object being to bring the cars from those lines to the West Side over the new Madison-street bridge, which is to be laid with standard gauge tracks.

The company is contemplating laying a single standard gauge track on each street, from the crossing of the Southern Pacific track at Clinton street south to Hawthorne avenue.

The company has been considering the advisability of laying a third rail on the Madison-street bridge, but the cost was found to be excessive in getting to the bridge on both sides of the river.

STEVENS MAY SECURE PLACE
