

HOP MARKET SOUND

Active Trading Season Is Yet to Come.

PRICES ON A GOOD BASIS

With No Competition Up to the Present Time, Values Have Been Well Maintained—Steady Tone in Wheat Market.

Only a few lots of hops have changed hands this week. There has been no falling off in the demand, but growers are not in a mood to sell at the current price. The market is very steady at 21 1/2 cents for good goods.

April and May are the principal buying months in this country, and as it takes about a month to get hops that, the heavy buying should begin before the close of the present month.

Buying for English shipment is likely to continue throughout the season and it may show an increase in the price of the hops in the market.

OREGON WOOL BRINGS GOOD PRICE

The failure had features about it that placed it out of the usual line of its particular business, notably in the extent to which its commitments were in bonds of properties.

There was some further pressure on the market which resulted in a sharp decline in the price of copper.
