FISHING SEASON NIGH

ANGLERS WITHOUT PERMITS AMENABLE TO ARREST.

Period Begins April 1 and to Continue Until November 1—1912 Walton Disciples Apply.

Fishermen who have not secured licenses from the County Clerk to fish in the state will be liable to arrest when fishing season opens, April 1. Deputy County Clerk Schneider, at the Courthouse, has thus far this year issued \$15 anglers' licenses, 287 combination licenses and 365 hunters' licenses. Following is a summary of the fishing laws of the state:

Beginning April 1 and continuing until November 1, trout may be taken with hook and line. Trout, salmon-trout and bass, however, may not be caught in any other way. It is unlawful to catch trout less than six inches long and not more than 7 1/2 inches long in a day. In Klamath County, however, the limit is 2 1/2 trout in a day, or not more than 20 pounds.
