

TRIAL OF MORRIS WILL BEGG TODAY

Charge of Embezzling \$75,000 in Notes and \$50,000 Cash First Against ex-Cashier.

W. H. MOORE TO TESTIFY

Attempt Is Believed to Have Been Made to Secure Promise to Recommend Fine if Plea of Guilty Should Be Made.

W. Cooper Morris will go to trial this morning on one of the charges of embezzling \$75,000 in notes and \$50,000 in cash from the Oregon Trust & Savings Bank on December 15, 1906.

The credit and debit slips showing this transaction and the testimony of W. H. Moore, ex-president of the bank, will be two of the strong features of the present trial.

Morris is believed to have endeavored, through his attorney, to secure from District Attorney Alexander Gordon, who is prosecuting the case, a promise to recommend a fine if Morris should plead guilty.

Louis J. Wilde's connection with the bank will probably be investigated by the grand jury chosen yesterday.
