Central Oregon Land Being Rapidly Taken Up.

PRINEVILLE IS FAVORITE

New Owners of Willamette Valley & Cascade Mountain Wagon Road Grant Actively Meeting Demands for Property.

The colonization of Central Oregon lands has already begun by the new owners of the Willamette Valley & Cascade Mountain wagon road grant.

When the grant was first purchased by the syndicate of Minnesota capitalists, it was announced that Prineville is to be the chief city of the state.

Prineville appears to have been favorably considered by one crowd of Minnesota men, who have just closed a deal for 1000 acres adjoining that town.

It is true that we have just closed with a St. Paul firm for the sale of 2000 acres adjoining Prineville. It is also true that we have sold more than 10,000 acres to actual settlers on the lands.

SOME POINTS YIELDED

BILLBOARD MEN PROPOSE TO REFORM THEMSELVES.

Draft of Ordinance Submitted in Hope of Staving Off Vote on Initiative Measure.

In an effort to forestall radical legislation by the Mayor, Street Car and Councilman Ellis, Foster & Kleiser, billboard monopolists, are framing an ordinance that is expected to lessen the onerous features of the business in Portland.

One of the chief features of the proposed ordinance, it is said, is a clause which prohibits any of the boards in residence sections to the city, it is understood, but whether they will be sufficient to stave off the circulation of the initiative petition, as contemplated, is unknown.

The contemplated initiative ordinance, proposed by Councilman Ellis, would not only prohibit any boards being placed in residence sections, unless with the consent of a majority of the owners, but it would restrict the size and the number of signs to be placed on the signs maintained by any company.
