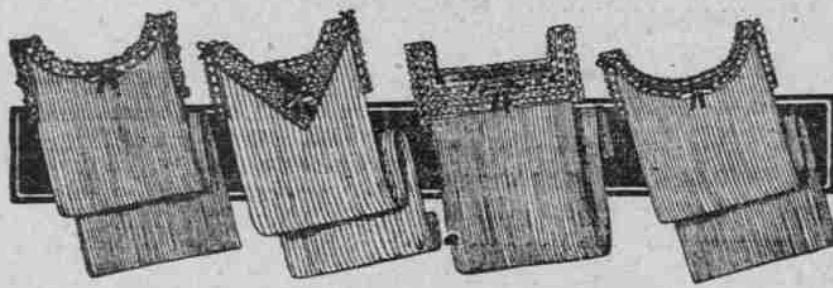

BALLINGER PLANS TOUR

Secretary to Visit Park; Assistant Goes to Yakima.

SEATTLE, July 14.—Secretary of the Interior Ballinger will leave next week for a tour of the Mount Rainier National Park to see what improvements can be made with the small appropriations allowed. E. C. Finney, assistant to Secretary

Ballinger, left tonight for North Yakima, where he will confer with C. H. Swigart, supervising engineer of the Yakima reclamation project. Before his return to Seattle he will visit Ellensburg to investigate the possibility of the construction of a high-line irrigation canal in that section. There is a demand for such a canal and for the extension of the present system.

Messenger Runs Down Pedestrian. G. W. Thompson, of 500 Hawthorne avenue, was run down by Willie Lang-

ley, a messenger boy, on a bicycle on Grand avenue, between Main and Madison streets, at 5 o'clock last night and painfully injured. Young Langley was taken into custody by the police, but upon the request of the injured man was not held.

Police Quell Riot When Sugar Company Imports Men.

NEW YORK, July 14.—The arrival today of a steam lighter bearing 200 laborers at the pier of the American Sugar Company's refinery in Williamsburg, where a strike is in progress, was the signal for a riot. A crowd of 100 or more men who had learned

of the boat's arrival charged toward the pier.

Reserve police interposed, and when the men began hurling bricks and stones the policemen used their clubs and dispersed the mob.

OREGON ELECTRIC ANXIOUS

Line Will Guarantee Extension If Given Franchise in Eugene.

EUGENE, Or., July 14.—(Special.)—"If the City Council will defer action for one week, we will ask for a franchise over Fifth street and will put up a bond to guarantee the extension of the Oregon Electric into Eugene within a very reasonable time," said Harrison Allen, attorney for the Oregon Electric, last evening, while the city authorities were being urged to grant a franchise to the Portland, Eugene & Eastern, who promised to begin construction within 24 hours.

Mr. Allen later said that it was the intention of the Oregon Electric to build to Eugene and run 22 trains each day over the line, as the company is now doing into Salem.
