#### NORMAL SCHOOL WANTED

Mr. Butler Seeks to Make Monmouth State Institution.

J. B. V. Butler, principal of the Monmouth High School, is in the city. Mr. Butler is actively interested in the movement to make Monmouth again a state normal school under the pending initiative act. In an interview he said: "The interest in the normal school question so far as Monmouth is concerned is steadily increasing. Reports coming from every quarter of the state indicate that the people recognize the value of the work done by this school in the past. The fact is also recognized that Oregon will have a school for the training of teachers and this institution—the pioneer school in this work in the state—rich in the work and traditions of its large alumni, and being centrally located appeals to them. There is a marked shortage in the supply of teachers for the public schools who have had training for their work and this will be felt more and more unless provision

#### PORTLAND RANKS SECOND

Bank Clearings Continue to Grow, Reaching \$9,517,000.

Bradstreet's bank clearings report for the week ending September 1 shows that Portland stands in second place of all the cities in the country in the percentage of increase in its bank clearings. The amount of the clearings is \$9,517,000 and the increase 47 per cent. Oakland leads the list in its increase with 127 per cent and its total is \$2,838,000.  
Helena, Mont., stands next to Portland in the increase, which is 44 per cent, but the clearings amount only to \$294,000. Seattle shows a wonderful decrease for the week, 82 per cent, with a total of \$9,907,000. Spokane shows a decrease of 103 per cent, and San Francisco the heaviest decrease on the Coast, 143 per cent.  
Consul Edwin S. Cunningham reports that a company has been formed in Durian, with a capital of about \$100,000, for the purpose of catching whales off the coast of Natal.
