WRATHER CONDITIONS A large high pressure field covers the central portion of the country and relatively how pressure obtains over the Lakes re-gion, along the Pacific Coast, over British Columbia, and there is a marked barometic depression off the Coast of South Carolina, where the tropical storm now is.
