TAZWELL NOT TO RESIGN

Rumor That Major Kennedy Will Go on Bench is Circulated.

Since Major J. F. Kennedy resigned as secretary of the Civil Service Commission two weeks ago, there has been persistent rumor in political circles that on February 1 he would succeed Municipal Judge Tazwell, of the Municipal Court, who, it was reported, would resign on that date. Judge Tazwell said last night that he had no intention of resigning, and, on the contrary, would remain on the bench and be a candidate for re-election.

"I have no intention of resigning," said Judge Tazwell. "I shall be a candidate for re-election. Does that look as if I contemplated resigning? I know there has been some talk that I would resign, but there is nothing to it. I shall remain on the bench in the Municipal Court and am a candidate to succeed myself."

CROSSING NOT PROTECTED

Council Asked to Require Trains to Stop at Sandy Road.

West-bound railroad trains must come to a standstill before crossing Sandy road, if the ordinance recommended to the City Council by the street committee yesterday becomes a law. The purpose of the ordinance is to provide protection to people crossing the tracks until the Council can determine whether a viaduct should be built across the tracks at that place.

The committee was not prepared to act on a suggestion at once that a viaduct should be built and on motion of Councilman Rushlight, seconded by Councilman Kubli, the City Attorney was authorized to prepare an ordinance to cause west-bound trains, which are on the down grade, to come to a full stop before crossing the street.

W. W. Cotton, legal representative of the O. W. R. & N., objected to the proposed ordinance, and asked that the present law limiting the speed of trains and cars in the city to six miles an hour be changed to a more liberal allowance. M. J. Buckley, assistant manager of the road, acknowledged to the committee that trains coming down Sullivan's gulch went at a greater rate than allowed by the city ordinance often reaching a speed in the city limits of 25 miles an hour.

TITLE CONCERN PROBED

Bar Association Committee to Report on Guarantees.

The Multnomah Bar Association will listen tonight to the report of a committee appointed to investigate the Title & Trust Insurance Company. E. S. J. McCallister, chairman of the committee, presented a report to President Schnabel yesterday afternoon.

The committee was appointed at the last meeting of the association to give an opinion as to proper procedure in certificates of title. It was contended that the company in question—the only one of its kind in the state—had insufficient capital to protect its guarantees of title, which now amount to a large sum.

The meeting will be held in Courtroom No. 3 of the Circuit Court at 8 o'clock tonight.
