

Gasoline Schooner to Operate in Coast Trade.

TRADE IS DEVELOPING

Vessel Will Be Larger Than Anvil, Recently Completed, and Will Be Ready for Yaquina Bay Service May 1, Next.

Development of the Oregon coast trade, which has been marked during the past year, has prepared the way for further tonnage to handle the ocean traffic and yesterday Elmors & Co., of Astoria, announced the awarding of a contract to Kruse & Co., of North Bend, for the construction of a gasoline schooner that will have a speed of 11 knots, and will be ready for service May 1. She will operate between Portland and Yaquina Bay ports, Galloway, and Sitka.

The new vessel will be larger than the gasoline schooner Anvil which sailed from Portland last week on her initial voyage to coast ports. She will be 135 feet long and have a beam of 23 feet and a 9 foot depth of hold. The Anvil is 116 feet long and has a 24-foot beam and 18.5 feet depth of hold, being equipped with twin screws and capable of considerable speed.

There are also orders to Tillamook from Portland the steamers Golden Gate and Sue H. Elmors and the Anvil took cargo for there on her first voyage, while the Golden Gate is now operating on the regular run from here and during the summer the gasoline schooner Belle was in the fleet. The Oshkosh runs principally from Astoria, making infrequent voyages from Elsie Bay.

I. W. Brown, representing the Olson & Mahony interests and in charge of Couch street dock, has advised an offer of a contract for the new schooner, as he also handles the Elmors' business and it is planned that both shall operate from the same berth.

LAUNCH IS FOR CUSTOM HOUSE Patrol Will Be Maintained on River This Season.

Authority has been received from Washington by Collector of Customs Malcolm to enter into a contract with the construction of a motor launch to be driven by a 24-horsepower engine. The craft will be 37 feet long and have a beam of 7.5 feet and is to be ready for service in three months.

For the launch and a house, the latter probably containing quarters for an engineer, \$2000 has been set aside. Specifications have been compiled and plans drawn, but they have not been returned from Washington and until they are available it will not be known when bids will be requested and the regulations entered last season it devolves on deputies of the Custom House to insist on a strict compliance with rules governing the equipment of motor craft. Last season pamphlets were distributed to owners and a campaign of education conducted among those who did not carry the proper bells, fog signals and gear. This year they will be accorded no leniency and the fact the Custom House will have a fact launch at its disposal and that it will take only a few hours reduces the chances for law-breakers navigating with short equipment.

SAINT DUNSTAN CHARTERED Superior Sails Direct on Next Voyage to Orient.

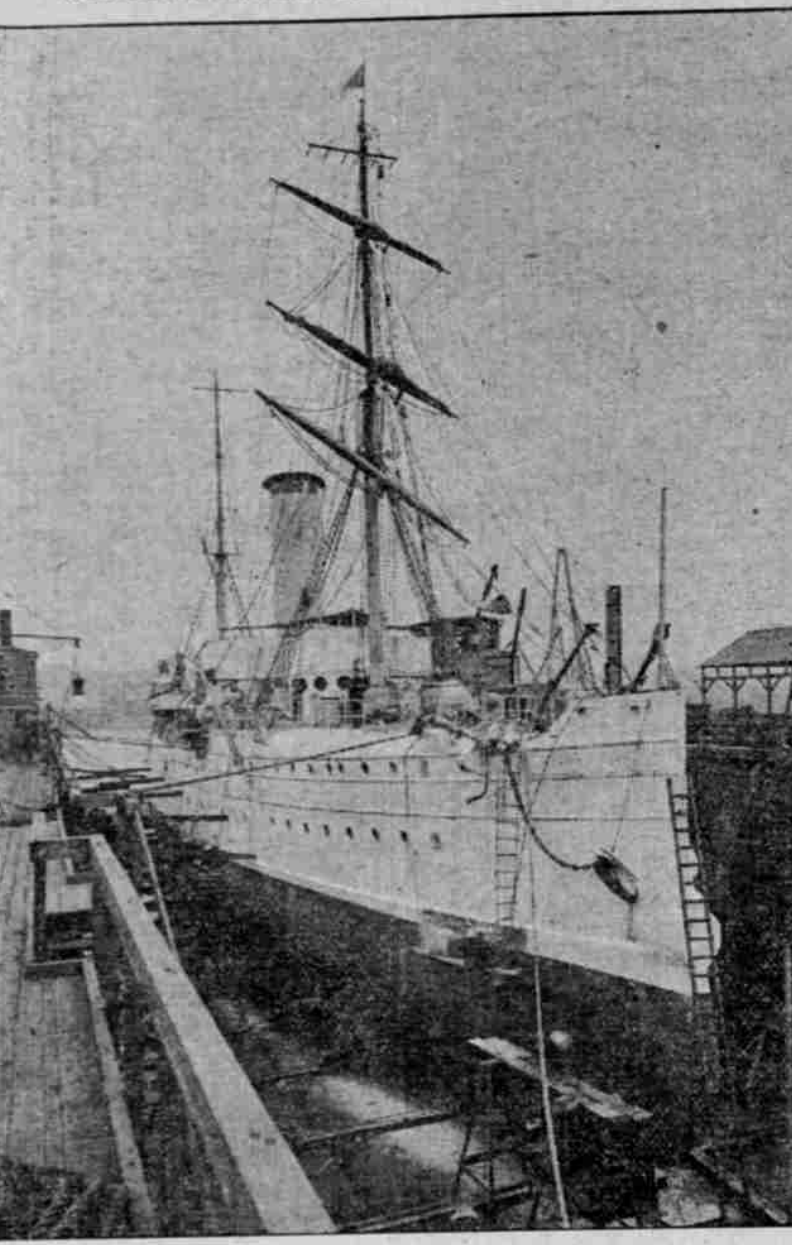
Of two trips chartered by Balfour, Guthrie & Co., the British steamer Saint Dunstan and British steamer Pirith Castle, to load at Antwerp for San Francisco, the Saint Dunstan probably will be ordered to proceed here with part cargo. Negotiations looking to her visit are under way and it is thought they will be closed this week. The steamer Pirith Castle, which is to be chartered for Antwerp for Portland, via Honolulu and San Francisco, is due at the latter port and will reach here early in February. It is said that when the Bank line's superior sails from here early in March she will clear direct for Far Eastern ports, instead of calling at Puget Sound to complete loading. Her cargo will be made up of wheat, flour and lumber. She is due February 21. The British steamer Strathmore, previously reported chartered, will be dispatched by Kerr, Gifford & Co. and is expected to get away for the United Kingdom next month.

LIGHT-VESEL LEAVES TODAY Relief Vessel No. 92 Will Proceed Inside From Reef.

It was cleaning day aboard Umatilla reef light-vessel yesterday and as she lay berthed at the outer dock of the Willamette Iron & Steel Works her crew washed down the vessel, prepared everything snug in advance of her departure today for Astoria. Steam was gotten up yesterday morning and after tests have been made of her boilers, after being re-tubed, and other work has been done over, she will have a final trial today on her journey to the lower harbor.

Shasta Bucks Southeaster. One of the worst hardluck stories of the season among mariners who weathered a blow without damage comes from San Pedro concerning the steamer Shasta, which reached there January 25, losing 13 days on the way from the Columbia River, a trip that is usually made in a third of the time. REVENUE CUTTER MANNING.

Few vessels seen in Portland which bared on drydock have drawn such admiring comment as the United States Revenue Cutter Manning, which is to float tomorrow from the Oregon drydock after having had repairs made to her hull and her entire body scraped and repainted. In appearance she is of the naval type.

In the annual list of American vessels, issued by the Department of Commerce and Labor, the home port of the Manning is given as Astoria and commercial interests hope that she will retain the station permanently.

Log Raft Stops Ferry. Another instance was witnessed yesterday by Harbormaster Speler of the inconvenience caused by masters of tow-boats handling log rafts, who practically block the harbor for ferries. One craft halted through the bridge soon after 10 o'clock in the morning and the Albina ferries were delayed because of the length of the raft. When the steamer was passing through the Steel bridge the raft barely cleared the route of the upper ferry.

Marine Notes. To take on more wheat the German bark Miami yesterday shifted to Montgomery dock No. 2 from Oceanic. One vessel yesterday cleared at the Custom-House, the steamer Roanoke, with general cargo for San Diego and way ports.

Robert McIntosh, who was awarded a contract by the Port of Portland Commission to repair the tug McCracken, plans to begin work Monday, if weather conditions permit.

John Gregory has been given a contract by the Port of Portland Commission to supply brush at \$15 a cord for use at the public drydock in connection with improvements being made to the basin.

With Captain Geer, of the steamer Stranger, as pilot, the steamers Wecon and Wentworth left for The Dalles last night, towing the whatnot, recently launched at Supply yards for the portage road. The Wentworth will return to Portland after assisting with the tow through the Cascades.

Today the British ship Balmoral will haul down from the North Bank dock to Martin's to load 500 tons of wheat and in the afternoon is to shift across the stream to Oceanic. Friday the German ship Elfrida will move from Linnton to Martin's to commence taking wheat.

The French bark Bossuet, which is in the stream at Linnton, will be shifted to a berth at the ballast dock. The body of Chief Mate Diehrich De Harde, of the German ship Elfrida, who was drowned at Linton late Tuesday night, while endeavoring to board the vessel, is thought to have missed the gangway and struck on a ballast log, being rendered helpless. He was married and had five or six children at his home in Westermunde, Germany. He was on the Elfrida 28 months.

Two narrow escapes from drowning were yesterday reported to have taken place Tuesday night, one in which a sailor fell from the British ship Celtic Glen, at Linnton, and was rescued by the watchman of the German ship Elfrida, and the other of a sailor from the French bark Bayard, in the harbor, who fell from the dock but managed to keep above water by kicking off heavy sea boots.
