Bellboy in New York Hotel Finds Body Long After Crime is Committed.

FIGHT FOR LIFE WAS MADE

Victim's Clothing Shows That She Made Desperate Struggle—Couple Registered as Married—Man Disappears Early in Day.

NEW YORK, Jan. 29.—The body of a young woman, strangled to death, in the opinion of the police, was found in a room on the second floor of the Bryant Hotel on Sixth avenue tonight.

The victim of the murder was about 20 years old. There was evidence that the woman had fought hard for her life. Her body was found lying partly upon the bed and partly upon the floor.

Lured to Place, Is Theory. The three central office detectives who investigated the mystery tonight became, after a few hours, convinced that the young woman was not a frequent visitor of the hotel.
