PRICES ON STEADY BASIS

Cattle of All Kinds Move Within the Former Range of Values—Good Sheep Wanted—Top on Hogs Is \$8.50.

There was a good run of livestock at the yards yesterday and more activity than has been seen for several days. The market in general was fairly steady. The demand for cattle embraced everything in the lot. Buyers paid \$2.25 to \$2.35 for steers, getting most of them around the 5-cent mark. Cows ranged from \$1.75 to \$2.25 with the bulk of sales at \$1.80. Calves sold mostly at \$7 for lightweights. Several fair size bunches of sheep were moved. Good ewes brought \$3.50 and wethers \$5.
