STRATHLYON IS IN PORT

STEAMER BRINGS 1000 TONS SULPHUR FROM ORIENT.

Portland & Asiatic Company Liner Passes Active Volcano on Aleutian Islands.

On her first trip into this port in the regular employ of the Portland & Asiatic Steamship Company, the steamer Strathlyon arrived from the Orient yesterday morning and tied up at the North Bank dock.

The Strathlyon, which brought 1000 tons of sulphur and general cargo from the Orient, experienced a hard trip across the Pacific, and looks rather much in need of paint, which it is expected will be given before she sails again.

The vessel is only three years old, and is one of the fleet of British vessels whose names all start with "Strath."

Sailing on the great circle, the Strathlyon came near the Aleutian Islands, and the active volcano on the islands produced an attractive view from the deck of the vessel.

The Strathlyon was 19 days in crossing the ocean from Yokohama, and on arrival at Astoria by the quarantine officials without first having to be fumigated, as she was fumigated just previous to sailing from this port.

Although this is the first time the Strathlyon has been in this port in the employ of the Portland & Asiatic Steamship Company, it is not her first visit to this port.
