Precipitation has been gen-eral on the Pacific slope, over the Northern Bockles, in lowa, and on the Atlantic slope, and high winds are reported from Puget Sound, the mouth of the Columbia Filver, and from Southwestern Utah. Warmer weather conditions in the Plains States, and temperatures are lower in Oklahoma. Ar-kanses, and in the South and Middle At-lantic States. Over the central portion of the country, temperatures are generally above the normal.




