

BEAVERS DISPLAY BATTING POWERS

Ryan's Coyotes Defeat McCredie's Squad 9 to 8—Six Home Runs Made.

GAME IS LOOSELY PLAYED

Chadbourne, Arlett, Kreuger, Fullerton and Peckinbaugh slam Ball Out of Lot—Remainder of Squad Now Enroute.

SANTA MARIA, Cal., March 12.—(Special.)—Before a large Sunday crowd, Ryan's Coyotes defeated McCredie's Beavers in a loose-played game, by the score of 9 to 8. Frequent long hits and a surfeit of errors marked the engagement though the see-sawing of the score kept the interest at fever heat.

There were six home-run drives made in the game. In the first inning, with Rodgers on first as first man up for the Coyotes, Chadbourne hit the ball over the right field fence for a home run, and after that Al Arlett connected for two homers. Fullerton, manipulated one and the fifth ramblod over the left field wall from Artie Krueger, who also picked out a couple of doubles during the afternoon.

Arlett's Work Sensational.

Shelby became wild about the fourth inning and the Beavers commenced scoring so promiscuously through passes and errors that they had a lead of seven to three at one stage of the game. Arlett played right field and then relieved Shelby on the mound and came through with two timely homers, the second of which scored Rodgers with the tying run in the last half of the ninth and then Arlett pitched a delayed message to Tommy Murray, who was at bat, and Arlett scored the first named with the winning run.

"Bugs" Russell pitched great ball for the Beavers, for only four hits were allowed by him, though two were homers by Fullerton and Chadbourne. Peckinbaugh and Rodgers played glib-edged ball at shortstop and second base in great style. Artie Krueger pulled off a couple of sensational catches in the outfield, and Rapp played star.

Tommy Murray sustained an injured thumb in the latter part of the game and Walter Kuhn caught for both teams in the last two innings. Murray will be all right in a day or so.

Steen Founded Hard.

Bill Steen relieved Russell in the sixth inning, but was so handicapped by his own foot, due to having been spiked the previous day, that he simply lobbed the ball up, and the Coyotes hit his offerings to all corners of the lot and out of it in the ninth inning.

Hugh McCredie, treasurer of the Boston American League, tonight telegraphed McCredie cancelling the Boston-Portland game, as train service on the Coast division of the Southern Pacific is so uncertain of resumption that the Red Sox will not be able to reach here. McCredie announced that the Beavers-Coyotes games will be played every day this week.

McCredie expects Koestner, Braden and Gough, as well as W. W. McLeod, on the first train due here tomorrow afternoon, and with the arrival of these players the Portland team will be practically intact in the training camp.

McCredie received a delayed message tonight saying that Neal Ball, his hold-out player, was at Chicago and is also advised of an offer from the Portland club offering to trade Second Baseman Finch and First Baseman Gambill, the latter formerly of the Sacramento club, for Ball. McCredie advised the Cleveland club of the offer and announced that he was opposed to trading Ball at this time as he figures that he is not very badly off for a second baseman and may need a couple of good pitchers later on. He said he did not think he would consider a trade for Ball until after the Pacific Coast League season opens, at the earliest, and perhaps not then.

COYLE PLANS STADIUM FUND

Washington Football Captain Sees Way to Meet End in Five Years.

UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON, Seattle, March 12.—(Special.)—Wesley William Coyle, captain of the University of Washington football team, has submitted a plan to the student body for control of the University of Washington in which he tells how within five years the University may have a sufficient sum to build a large stadium on Denney field to replace the inadequate inclosure now being used.

The plan is to raise the student fee from \$5 to \$10 and the extra dollar as the stadium fund. As there will be more than 200 at the University the fund would reach \$20,000 without interest. It is proposed each year to add to the fund and place it at 4 per cent interest. A stadium similar to that of the Tacoma High School but larger is Coyle's plan. Colleges throughout the conference have complained about Washington's field and in football season it is far too small to accommodate the large crowds.
