However, it was an off day with the visitors and Archer did not have as good support as Klein did. The Angels played an errorless game while the three errors of the Portland team were costly. Klein also had the crowd of fans with him, which helped some. Every time he appeared, he was given a round of applause.

The game was short on benches and features. Sheehan made the first hit off Klein in the fourth inning, with a single to right. A moment later he stole second and scored on Rapp's double to right center. It was the only run the visitors managed to acquire during their nine innings.

Angels Begin in Fourth.

The Angels began their run-getting in the fourth, when Metzger scored on Peckinpaugh's low throw to Rapp, after he had singled and been advanced by Moore's single.

In the fifth, the Angels tallied twice. Delmas drew a base. Deal drove to Rodgers, who tossed the ball high to Peckinpaugh, putting Delmas on third. Deal reached second on Peckinpaugh's low throw to Sheehan.

Delmas turned his ankle in sliding into third and Delhi the small but fleet youngster, was put in to run for him. Smith sent a long sacrifice fly to Chadbourne, Delhi scoring and Deal going to third after the catch. Klein singled to right scoring Delmas.

Moore went to third and Daley to second after the catch. Deal fanned.
