China is Well Supplied for the Present.

NATIVE WHEAT AVAILABLE

Opening of the Year Saw Immense Receipts of Oregon and Washington Product at the Port of Hongkong.

The flour market in South China is showing some signs of a reaction, after the big shipments that were made from Oregon and Washington in the last two months of 1910 and the first two months of 1911.

While the Hongkong and Shanghai markets were in the midst of the boom, orders were sent to six North Pacific Coast points which kept some mills busy for three months on this business alone.

The flour arrived in immense cargoes, half a million bags having arrived in Hongkong during the week.
