Complete unofficial returns from anday's municipal election give A. G. ushlight. Republican nominee and Monday's municipal election give A. G. Rushlight. Republican nomines and Mapor-elect. a plurality of \$337 over Mayor Simon, the Independent Commission-Government candidate. Mr. Rushlight lacked fewer than \$90 voice of having a majority over his four opponents for the office. The combined vote against Mr. Rushlight, who poiled 12,762 votes, was only 14,506.

Councilman Concannon, of the First Ward: Belding, of the Sixth, and Kubil, of the Eighth, were all defeated for re-election, according to the complete unofficial returns. The official count will not materially change the lead registered against them.

Two Beat Concannon.

In the three-cornered fight in the First Ward, Concannon was retired by a decisive vote, being outdistanced by both Tom N. Monka, Democrat, who succeeds him in the Council, and by fordan V. Zan, the Republican nomi-

In the Sixth Ward, Councilman Beldin the sixth ward, Councilman assi-ing was defeated by John Montag. Democrat, a member of Mayor Pen-noyer's Executive Board, ex-Council-man and at one time candidate for Mayor. Mr. Montag has a majority of is over both Beiding and the Socialist

nomined.

William Schmeer, a Republican, who ran as an independent against Councilman Kubii in the Eighth, won by a plurality of 116. Councilman Eills, in the Tenth Ward, apparently has retained his seat in the Council, the oftained his real him having failed, actained his seat in the Council, the effort to recall him having falled, according to the unofficial returns. These figures give Eills a piscality of it votes over his closest competitor, James Maguire. It is not likely that the official count will change this result.

Wilhelm and Joy Win.

Frederick S. Wilhelm, Republican, will succeed George L. Baker as Councilman from the Fourth Ward, having defeated his Democratic and Socialist epponents by a majority of \$21. The same is true of Allan R. Joy, Republican, who has been elected Councilman from the Seventh Ward to succeed Mayor-elect Rushlight. Mr. Joy had a majority of \$128 over his three competitors.

Council to Buy Site.

Under the provisions of the amendment authorizing a bond issue of \$200,000 for the purchase of ground and the construction of a municipal building. the Council is empowered to buy the

site and to sell the bonds. The Executive Board then takes charge, awards a contract for the building and has charge of the building after it is completed. The building is to house the police department. Municipal Court, City Jall and Emergency Hospital.

The amendments exacting from gas and electric companies a tax of three per cent of the gross receipts become effective as soon as they are proclaimed by the Mayor to be laws. They were aimed to work with the proposed public service bill, which was defeated, in that they were calculated to provide the revenue for payment of salin that toey were calculated to provide the revenue for payment of sal-aries of three \$5000-a-year commis-sioners and the incidentals of opera-tion. The companies coming under this provision are required to furnish the City Treasurer with correct statements

City Treasurer with correct statements of their receipts by March I each year. The amendment authorizing the levy of 1 mill annually for the use of the street-cleaning and sprinkling department serves only to decrease the burden on the general fund. It will not provide sufficient money to defray all of the cost of this department, based on the present assessed valuation of the city, but will help considerably. The remainder must be paid for out of the general fund.

Fills on Par With Bridges.

Under the provisions of the amend ment authorising payment for all fills costing more than \$15,000 out of the general fund, abutting or benefited property will escape the cost hitherto






