GOVERNOR WEST ACTS

Executive Appoints New Boarding-House Commission to Succeed McMaster, Souls and Smith.

Deadline Heritage Left.

Governor West has taken a hand in the State Boarding-House Commission situation, having launched yesterday a new personnel to include J. W. Ganong, vice-president of the Portland Sailing Club; Captain Spencer, Harbormaster of Portland, and J. Andrew Madsen, secretary and treasurer of the Pacific district of the International Longshoremen's Association. They succeed William McMaster, William H. Souls and A. M. Smith.

Old Law Changed.

At the last session of the Legislature the sailor boarding-house law was amended so that boarding-house masters no longer exist. It is an offense to harbor common-law sailors, and a fee of \$5 was reduced to \$3 as the fee to be accepted for every sailor by a shipping master. The advance was not distributed, but the law is now in effect as a matter of fact.

Grant Continues Business.

As it was not known definitely when Commissioner Smith would return, a deadlock was the result, and as his application had not been denied Grant proceeded to follow the vocation of shipping master.

Opium Seizure on Kumeric

Chinese Sailors Have Six Cans of Drug Hidden Over Door.

What is believed to be a portion of a large amount of opium brought here on the British steamer Kumeric from the Orient was discovered yesterday aboard the vessel after a search by Chief Inspector of Customs and acting under instructions from Collector of Customs Malcolm, and six cans, said to be valued at \$400, were confiscated. The opium was found in the forecastle, secreted above the door having been placed by members of the Chinese crew.

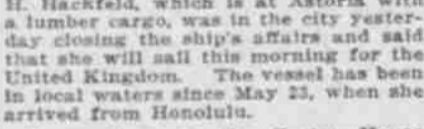
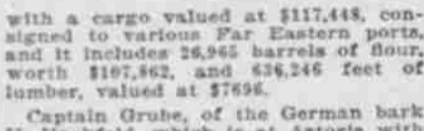
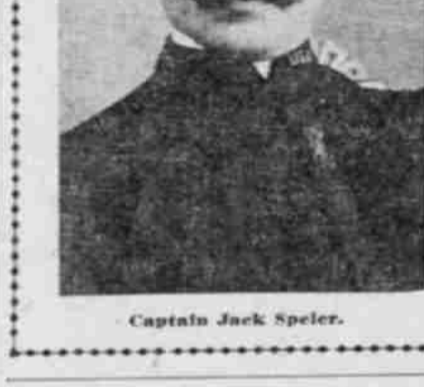

Strict Watch to Follow

Restrictions that have been disregarded until almost completely forgotten, will confront the automobile driver who ventures into the downtown district during the arduous of the campaign. He must have his license tag properly displayed, with a white light shining full upon it at night; he must have two sets of brakes, either of which will stop the car within ten feet when running ten miles an hour; he must keep his speed down to ten miles an hour on the straightaway, six miles at turns and four miles at crossings where streetcars turn; he may not pass between the curb and any car stopping to take on passengers; he must shut off his engine when he stops at any time he may cut out his muffler.
