Mile. Minar appeared as "The Darling of Paris" at the Portland Orpheum a few weeks ago. News of her death was a shock to employees of the local theater.

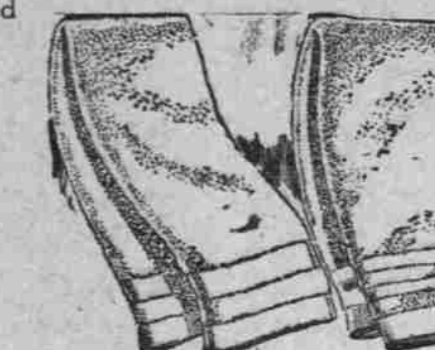
