CONVENTION WANTED HERE

Portland Universalists Vote to Bring 1913 Meeting to This City.

The parish of the Church of Good Tidings, Universalist, at Broadway and East Twenty-fourth streets, has voted unanimously to invite the Universalist General Convention to hold its 1913 session in Portland. Rev. James D. Corby and E. J. Jaeger have been chosen as delegates and will be at Springfield, Mass., during the convention from October 18 to October 22. They are in touch with many of the Western delegates and have wide acquaintance with Eastern representatives who will favor the campaign for Portland. The convention will use the three large Universalist churches in Springfield, Mass., for its sessions, and the

programme committee has invited Dr. Corby to preside at the great public meeting October 10, when F. W. Hamilton, president of Tufts College in Boston, and G. E. Butterfield, of Detroit, Mich., will speak.

The convention promised to be large as the greatest strength of the church is in New England, more than 50 Universalist churches being in greater Boston alone. Many leading workers for reform and social uplift are expected, among them Clara Barton, long the head of the Red Cross work; Mrs. Stevens of the Women's Christian Temperance Union, and Rev. Henry N. Couden, the blind chaplain of Congress. The Portland delegates aim to arouse such enthusiasm that the official board will vote to expand the work in the Northwest greatly, sending some of their strongest workers to master the problems of this section. If the convention accepts the invitation to come to Portland in 1913 it

will mean that between 1000 and 1500 delegates will attend from all sections of the United States. The delegates will leave next week and with literature and pictures of Portland and the Northwest.

Scott to Arrange Excursion West. John M. Scott, assistant general passenger agent for the O.-W. R. & N. Company and the Southern Pacific lines in Oregon, has gone to Winnipeg, Man., where he will recruit passengers for an excursion to be conducted from that city to Portland and California soon after the first of the year. A similar trip was conducted by the Harriman lines last year and proved successful. The travelers are privileged to stop in Portland a day or two each way. As a result of their visit many who were on the last excursion subsequently came to Portland to invest. Some expect to come here to live.

HOLGATE SEWER VIEWED

Officials Find That Contractors Filled After Complaints.

Mayor Ruahlight, City Engineer Huriburt and members of the Sewer Committee of the Executive Board, visited the Holgate Sewer District yesterday morning to see for themselves the condition of the territory in which the new sewer has been laid, and to determine whether there is ground for complaints that the trenches were not filled properly. They found that Gibbish & Joplin, the contractors, had been over the ground after complaints were made that water was not used in filling the trenches, and had refilled where necessary. City Engineer Huriburt said it is impossible to do perfect filling in the

district because many of the streets are only graded, not paved. The district is bounded by Holgate street, Francis avenue, East Sixteenth street and East Forty-first street.

Aero Postcard at Forest Grove. FOREST GROVE, Or., Oct. 2.—(Special.)—A postal card, carried by aeroplane came through the Forest Grove postoffice last week. The card was dated at London, September 9, and bore the postmark, "United Kingdom Aeroplane Post." It was sent to Mr. and Mrs. T. H. Littlehales, of this city, by friends in England and is among the first in the world to be carried by that method on an official mail route.
