The tonnage, inward and outward, of this port for the first nine months of the present year has shown a steady and healthy increase over the same period of last and previous years.

The arrivals of sugar from January 1 to October 1 amounted to 1,100,000 lbs., as against 1,000,000 lbs. for the same period last year.

The inward tonnage in the same period this year was 1,212,811, and last year it was 1,012,202, the outward being 1,110,685 in 1911, against 957,737 in 1910.
