

WHEAT EXPORTS OF PORTLAND

Portland Shipment of Wheat 1,397,384 Bushels Above Puget Sound Points.

SEASON OUTLOOK BRIGHT

Trade Record of November of Past Year Expected to Be Passed by Shippers in Coming Month.

European Demand Big.

For the season to date, which marks the first quarter of the cereal year, the total shipments from Puget Sound ports 1,057,493 bushels of wheat, a gain over the first four months of the 1910-11 period of 765,248 bushels and in the shipment of 1,065,743 bushels foreign last month the showing for September was bested by 41,511 bushels. The exportation of flour made the heaviest increase in 1911, 137,869 bushels, and in the aggregate 15,168 barrels for last October, and the month's offshore business is in excess of the combined flour and coastwise trade for that period, which aggregated 72,594 barrels, including 28,977 barrels sent to California, there was a total of 177,965 barrels.

Puget Sound shipped to all ports 774,739 bushels of wheat, which gives Portland a lead for the month of 279,645 bushels. Since the season began this has floated to foreign and coast destinations 2,982,840 bushels and Puget Sound 1,397,384 bushels. The California and Oriental markets have not drawn as much wheat this season as last, but the combined flour and coastwise trade through heavier shipments to Europe.

The port record for a single month's flour exportation, which was made in June, 1907, but October's total is the best subsequent amount. The increase was limited to the amount of tonnage available, because there was a greater demand for breadstuffs, but it could not be moved by the Bank Line.

In November, 1910, wheat exports aggregated 870,480 bushels, valued at \$717,613, and at least three cargoes are in sight for this month, two of which will be shipped to the Pacific coast, intended for the British bark Arracan and the other for the German ship Diana, both of which commenced loading yesterday. The French ship La Flanche will not have the last of her ballast out until about Saturday and may start working outward cargo next week. Wheat and flour carried on the British steamer Robert Dollar will help swell the totals and with two other Oriental liners to sail it is hoped to exceed the four cargoes of last November, which amounted to 51,172 barrels.

PORT DENIES ALL LIABILITY

Accident to Reuce May Result in Legal Complications.

Captain Albert Crowe, of Anderson, Crowe & Co., who have a contract for repairing the ship Reuce, which was damaged on the public drydock Thursday, when she "skidded" from the keel blocks and was damaged, has been informed by the Port of Portland Commission that the board will not admit liability for the accident. Work on the Reuce has been suspended as originally planned and besides repairs to be made to her keel, she will be caulked completely instead of in certain lines, and her hull will be refastened where necessary.

It is expected that if the question of damages is not adjusted by attorneys for the Port and the owners, the matter will be taken into court. The cause of the accident has not been determined, only theories being advanced and at a meeting yesterday no new information was given bearing on the case.

CHANCELLOR FINISHES LOAD

First Harrison Line Carrier Departs for London.

Balfour, Guthrie & Co. are endeavoring to interest shippers in the Harrison line, which is operating from the United Kingdom to the Pacific coast, and its vessels touch all principal ports from San Pedro to Victoria if they have sufficient cargo aboard to warrant. The British steamer Chancellor, under the command of Captain London, so her salmon cargo will be given early delivery.

NOVEMBER SHIPMENTS HEAVY

Oregon Oats Must Wait for December Steamers.

Attractive quotations on oats at San Francisco have delayed the San Francisco & Portland Steamship Company with applications for space, but so far only one lot will move in November that is destined to the Pacific coast, which sails Friday. More than 1000 tons were offered yesterday, but so many space reservations have been made that it could not be accommodated until December.

LUMBER TRADE INCREASING

October Exceeds Same Periods for Last Two Seasons.

Lumber shipments made a surprising jump in October, and with 14,962,822 feet exported and 12,320,000 feet sent coastwise, the total was less than two tramp cargoes from the port record, the combined business being 26,282,822 feet. The best showing in local monthly lumber movements was in August, 1910, when 20,253,886 feet was floated. The September showing coastwise was good, as 11,580,252 feet were shipped, though that indicated a small decrease over August, with 12,838,422 feet a year ago the coastwise trade drew from here 7,760,000 feet, and in October, 1909, the movement measured 14,910,000 feet.

REGISTRY PLACE NEEDED

County Clerk Would Put House on Plaza to Accommodate Voters.

Estimating that 40,000 persons will register next year for the Presidential election, County Clerk Fields yesterday sent a letter to Mayor Knudsen, requesting that a registration office be built in the Plaza block east of the County Courthouse. Mr. Fields says the County Clerk's office is not large enough to accommodate the residents who will want to register, it being estimated that 500 persons will register every day between January 2 and April 1.

Two years ago 36,000 registered and this year there will easily be 40,000 more, writes Mr. Fields. It is declared that it would be expensive for the county to attempt to handle the registration in the Courthouse and that a small building in the Plaza block would facilitate the registration for officials and voters.

The registration will continue from January 2 to April 9 and from April 24 to October 29. The Mayor referred the request to the Park Board, which is to meet at the City Hall this morning.
