GERMAN IS ANSWERED

British Official Says Settlement of Dispute Over Morocco Is Great Relief to All of European Powers.

LONDON, Nov. 9.—A new Lord Mayor of London, Sir Thomas Boor Crosby, M. D., was elected today.

The settlement of the questions involved in the Morocco dispute is a relief to Europe, for it removes perhaps the greatest obstacle to the smooth working of European diplomacy.

BAKER'S PROTEST LOSES

Railroad Commission Overrules Remonstrance Affecting Cases.

SALEM, Or., Nov. 9.—(Special.)—At the regular session of the Railroad Commission Wednesday was presented the remonstrance of the Baker Commercial Club against the consolidation of its complaints against the Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company with the distance tariff investigation commenced by the Commission upon its own motion and set for hearing November 15.

The Commission in response to the remonstrance, overruled the same as far as the class rates out of Baker were concerned and ordered that the commodity rates be taken up for consideration, and then handed in an order dismissing the same, together with the various petitions in intervention which had been filed by other communities.

RAILWAY LANDS GO TO YAKIMA INDIANS

Northern Pacific Loses 250,000 Acres Granted Erroneously Years Ago.

CASE WILL BE APPEALED

Territory in Eastern Washington Worth \$3,000,000 to Revert to Government, Rules Federal Circuit Court of Appeals.

SPOKANE, Wash., Nov. 9.—(Special.)—Patents to 255,000 acres of Yakima Indian reserve land, valued at approximately \$3,000,000, and not included in the present boundary of the reserve, which were erroneously granted to the Northern Pacific many years ago, have been canceled by the United States Circuit Court of Appeals. All this land will go to the Indians.

The suit was originally started in January, 1907, to cancel the patent because of an erroneous survey, enlarged by this decision, the new boundaries of the Yakima Indian reserve will include Mount Adams.

This decision comes as a result of the unanimous verdict of the Circuit Court of Appeals at San Francisco which has affirmed the findings of the Federal Court for the Eastern district of Washington.

A telegram from the chief counsel of the Northern Pacific Railway at St. Paul today says that the case will be appealed to the Supreme Court of the United States.
