Opposition of Tacoma Faction Expected to Be Factor in 'Progressive' Assembly.

SEATTLE LEADERS STRONG

TACOMA, Wash., Dec. 4.—(Special.)—The conference of "Progressive" League delegates of the state, called by the King County Progressive Republican League, to meet in Tacoma tomorrow to demand an extra session of the Legislature to enact a Presidential preference primary law, will convene at 10 o'clock tomorrow morning in the Temple of Music. Although the conference is to be held in Tacoma, local "progressive" Republicans, split as they are over allowing the Seattle League its assumed dictatorship, are very much in the air tonight as to just how tomorrow's thoughtfest will be conducted and who, as chairman and other officers, will direct the trend of action.

Some of the local men would venture an opinion as to how many delegates will be here. They say the Seattle League has neglected to send a copy of the "state" over here for the local leaders, although announcing in Seattle papers that there would be two "conferences" one in the morning exclusively executive, while at the afternoon gathering Governor Hay and the general public would be invited in. DR. HYDE FIGHTING HARD

Defendant Would Exclude His Testimony in First Murder Trial.

TEACHERS' PAY TO RISE

District Four in Lane County Approves Levy for Purpose.

EUGENE, Or., Dec. 4.—(Special.)—After levying the tax of 5.8 mills asked by the school board, the taxpayers of District No. 4 tonight reconsidered and added four-tenths of a mill to the levy, with the proviso that the added money should be used to increase salaries of teachers.

Report of the board showed that schools had been maintained at a point of efficiency on last year's levy, street assessments and other obligations had been paid before delinquency, at great saving of interest, and there remains ample funds to complete the fiscal year.

SUPREME COURT DECIDES

Quashing of Indictments Against Munday and Shiels for Alleged Frauds Unanimous Opinion.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 4.—The Supreme Court of the United States today opened the way for the Federal Government to prosecute coal land frauds in Alaska by holding that the general coal land laws of the United States, which forbid persons or associations from making more than one entry, apply to the unsurveyed coal regions of Alaska.

The immediate result of this holding was the reversal of the action of the United States Circuit Court for Western Washington in quashing an invalid indictment against Charles F. Munday and Archie W. Shiels, on charges of conspiracy to defraud the Government out of coal lands in Alaska valued at \$10,000,000. The way is now opened for their trial on this charge.

Court is Unanimous.

Justice Lurton gave the unanimous opinion of the court. He considered the argument of the defendants that the act of Congress in 1904 superseded the general laws, so far as the unsurveyed lands of Alaska were concerned.

"There occurs to us no reason for assuming that Congress intended to abandon the policy of keeping open the right of every citizen to enter one tract and no more of the unsurveyed coal lands of Alaska, that would not lead also to the abandonment of the policy as respects coal lands which had been surveyed," said the court. "An intention to depart from a uniform policy so long enforced in regard to the coal land should not be imputed

RULING CLEARS WAY

Alaska Coal Land Frauds Can Now Be Prosecuted.

POWER-OF-ATTORNEY IS HIT

Rich Stacey Claimants Lose All by Court Decision.

SEATTLE, Dec. 4.—According to land office officials, the Supreme Court decision puts an end forever to the contention of the power-of-attorney claimants to Alaska coal lands.

Today's decision sustains that of United States District Judge Frank Rudkin in the Doughten case, rendered at Spokane and reverses United States District Judge Hanford, who on April 8, 1911, in Seattle, quashed the indictment charging Charles F. Munday and Archie Shiels with conspiracy to defraud the United States of the coal lands and possession of certain coal lands in the Bering River district known as the Stacey group.

The Stacey claims are situated near the Cunningham lands and are said to be more valuable. These lands are the richest undeveloped coal body in the world. The Stacey claims were located by Algernon H. Stacey, of Vancouver, B. C., a brother of Sir Edward Stacey, a millionaire baronet and Liberal member of the British Parliament. All the claims are now held by Charles F. Munday, a Seattle lawyer, under an irrevocable power of attorney.

According to land office records, Munday organized the Alaska Development Company in 1897, and later went to England, where he interested British capitalists, including Sir Edward Stacey, in a scheme of obtaining ownership of Alaska coal lands. At that time there were no coal land laws covering Alaska.

In 1909 Congress passed an act extending the land law of 1875 to Alaska. With this law behind him, Land Office officials say, Algernon H. Stacey sent 42 employees of the Pacific Coast Oil Company, some unable to speak

\$62,000,000 SAVED NATION

Railroad's Suit to Recover Value of Land Is Lost.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 4.—A \$62,000,000 claim of the Missouri, Kansas & Texas Railway Company, against the United States was dismissed today when the Court of Claims sustained the Government demurrer to the railway's petition for reimbursement for every alternate section of land along its lines through the Indian Territory, now part of the State of Oklahoma.
