PURCHASES ARE EXTENSIVE

Cheaper Class of Goods Available

There Than in Oregon—Local Trading Is Light—Conditions in England.

Eastern hop dealers have turned their attention to California.

The activity in the Southern state is accounted for by the fact that a cheaper grade of hops is available there than in Oregon.

Market conditions in England are reported by the Kenish Observer of November 22, as follows:

Imports of hops last week, 2685 cwt. In corresponding week 1910, 4900 cwt. Exports last week, 1222 cwt.

The supplies of new hops are getting more restricted every week, and holders are asking still higher prices.

There was no new feature in Worcester, where very few hops were offered at the recent sale.

BONEY RATES FIRM

Advance Has Depressing Effect on Stock Trading.

BEARS FORCE PRICES DOWN

Active Issues Close the Day With Losses of a Point or More—Wash Securities Touch New Low Records—Bonds Heavy.

NEW YORK, Dec. 5.—The movement of prices on the stock exchange today so nearly duplicated those of the previous days of the week that the market appeared to have settled into a rut.

Towards the close bears repeated their earlier tactics, bringing the session to an end with a sharp attack, which depressed prices.

Along the active stocks—Union Pacific, Reading, Lehigh Valley and Amalgamated Copper—were forced a point or more below the previous day's close.

Maintenance of call money rates at higher figures was regarded as an important factor in governing trading.

Further selling of inactive industrials, such as has been in progress for several days, resulted in some substantial losses.

Real estate securities preferred had established a new record today by declining to 100.

In Wash securities both the stocks and bonds touched new low records for the movement.

The bond market was heavy, with especially severe declines in some of the lower priced speculative issues.

Working balances in Treasury of \$1,000,000,000, United States 4s, coupon, declined 1/4 cent.
